When do you want to vote in the November 2020 election?

Before Election Day

On Election Day

Are you...

- incapacitated or confined due to illness or caring for someone who is?
- at high risk for COVID-19? (e.g., you're 65+, live in long-term care, have diabetes or suffer from heart, immune system, kidney, liver or lung conditions)

Step 1 Confirm your **voter registration** and **polling place** on the MO Secretary of State's website.

Step 2 Go vote in person on Tuesday, Nov 3rd. Be sure to bring an ID, such as your voter card, drivers license, or utility bill. Remember, if you're in line by 7pm, you get to vote!

You're qualified to vote absentee without a notary.

Do you want to vote **remotely** or **in-person**?

Remotely

In-person

Submit your **absentee ballot request** by mail, fax, email, or in-person by Wednesday, Oct 21st.

Once you receive your ballot, fill it out and return it by mail or drop it off in-person at your election authority. They must receive it by 7pm on Tuesday, Nov 3rd.

Take your ID (such as your voter card, drivers license, or utility bill) to your local election authority or a satellite location between Tuesday, Sept 22nd and Monday, Nov 2nd and cast your absentee vote.

Remotely

Submit your **absentee ballot request** by mail, fax, email, or in-person by Wednesday, Oct 21st.

Step 1 Fill out your ballot.

Step 2 Get your ballot envelope **notarized**.

Return your **notarized** ballot via mail or drop it off in-person at your election authority. They must receive it by 7pm on Tuesday, Nov 3rd.

You're qualified for a mail-in ballot.

Submit your **mail-in ballot request** to your local election authority by Wednesday, Oct 21st by mail or in-person drop off.

Once you receive it...

Fill out your ballot.

Get your ballot envelope **notarized**.

Return your **notarized** ballot with a stamp (to get it there faster) by USPS mail. **A mail-in ballot can only be returned by USPS.** Your local election authority must receive it by 7pm on Tuesday, Nov 3rd.
